The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the May 26, 2020 meeting were read and approved. The Fiscal Officer's report was also approved.

Discussion started with the Webster School property. Angie Miesmer would like to see Eastwood softball teams ages 8U through 14U play on the ball diamonds for the spring and summer seasons and continue to allow the soccer association to use the property in the fall. Angie Miesmer currently coaches an 8U team and wants to use the south field starting June 21. Greg Gonyer currently coaches a 14U team through Velocity, a program with lots of Eastwood kids as well as kids from other districts. Greg Gonyer would like to see Velocity teams use the property in the spring, summer, and share with the soccer association in the fall. Tracy Rollins is the President of Velocity and explained there may be up to 14 Velocity teams in the summer, with less teams in the spring and fall. Velocity carries insurance including additional insurance due to COVID-19. Angie Miesmer's team is covered under this insurance as well. Angie Miesmer and Velocity both offered to pay for a portable restroom at the property. Both teams would like to use the concession stand, however access to electricity and water would greatly expand their options. Both teams think hosting a tournament at the property would be a great way to generate revenue that would be used to maintain the property. Isaac Bailey can work with Greg Gonyer and other volunteers to get the north field in playing condition. Using both the north and south field would mean the soccer association would have to rearrange their fields and potentially move one field back to Stony Ridge. Greg Gonyer has many sponsors willing to donate time or resources. Isaac Bailey made a motion to let Greg Gonyer utilize the north diamond and let Angie Miesmer utilize the south diamond for the summer season. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor. Each will be in charge of maintaining their fields, and each can let other teams play on their fields if the scheduling works. The Trustees will see how things go and revisit the issue before the next season.

Randy Aspacher asked about the plan for the playground. Jim Cajka is still trying to get someone from the Parks District to come look at it. Randy Aspacher will try to pull some of the old equipment out. Chase Greulich is working on getting some mulch. The Trustees discussed the old bus garage and agreed it should be torn down.

Julie Foos received the sample bid packet from the County for Main Road, and discussed some of the details. The Trustees would like to open the bids on July 13. Mark Bushman moved to put Main Road improvement out for bid. Isaac Bailey seconded the motion and all were in favor.

The Trustees agreed the stone section of Anderson Road is still holding up well. Mark Bushman talked to ODOT about the north section of Anderson Road and was told there are no more funds available. Julie Foos will send a bill for berming expenses anyways.

Mark Bushman also talked to the pipeline inspectors and was told the township would most likely not receive any money for damages to Anderson Road. Mark Bushman has not had any luck getting ODOT to fix the corner of Silverwood and 105, so he asked the County to look at.

There was nothing to report on the fire and EMS contracts, abandoned houses, 911 address signs, or replacements on the Zoning Boards.

Isaac Bailey reported the contractor spraying the roadsides will be in the area around the second week of July and will spray ten miles.

Julie Foos will continue to work on the cemetery mapping project. Julie Foos and Mark Bushman will review and update the cemetery rules before the next meeting.

The meeting turned to new business. Randy Aspacher reported the mower was in storage at Zach Aspacher's from December 1 to May 28. The Trustees agreed to pay \$60/month.

Isaac Bailey moved to open the hall back up for rentals. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor. The Trustees agreed to hold only one event per weekend. Each party will be responsible for cleaning before and after their event.
