The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the July 26, 2021 meeting were read and approved. The Fiscal Officer's report was also approved.

Discussion started with the Webster School property. Mark Bushman reported Morton Buildings is planning on finishing up the storage building next week. Mark Bushman is still holding the final check until the building is completed. Jim Cajka had the plans for electricity from Matt Meyer Electric and will get them to the County Building Inspection department. Sarver and Sons Construction installed the sidewalk going from the parking lot, alongside the playground, to the south bleachers. The Trustees discussed what to do with the bleachers since they do not meet the current safety requirements. There was nothing to report on the athletic field reservation paperwork or shelter house. Julie Foos mentioned someone had asked if they could have the monkey bars that were removed from the playground. Mark Bushman will contact him.

The County chip sealed Devils Hole Road from Carter Road to Luckey Road, but has not completed Silverwood Road yet. Jim Cajka suggested having the County chip seal Nelson Road from Silverwood Road to Webster Road when they are working on Silverwood Road. Mark Bushman will ask the County.

There was nothing to report on the Durapatcher work agreement, abandoned houses or quotes for ~~chip~~ sealing Webster Township Cemetery.

The Trustees reviewed the quotes for repairing or replacing the flags at Webster Township Cemetery and the Township Hall. Jim Cajka made a motion to buy two 25 foot fiberglass flagpoles. Mark Bushman seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

The Trustees and Julie Foos discussed applying for the American Rescue Plan money and the need to create another fund to put the money in.

Julie Foos reported the auditor picked up the records for the 2019 and 2020 audit.

Jim Cajka mentioned Sarver and Sons Construction is willing to continue to mow the Township Hall yard if it gets rolled. Jim Cajka will talk to Zach Sarver about it again.

The Trustees agreed to have the township pay the \$300 bill from the Wood County Township Association, and each Trustee will reimburse the township personally.

Isaac Bailey reported Randy Aspacher is going to use the township truck to help haul dirt away from some of the properties when the Dunipace Ditch gets cleaned to save money.

Randy Aspacher asked if the township could hire another part time employee to help him out on an as needed basis. Randy Aspacher suggested rehiring Mark Moore, the township's previous part time employee. Randy Aspacher mentioned the scheduling conflicts that prompted Mark Moore to leave the job a few years ago no longer exist. Jim Cajka made a motion to hire Mark Moore for part time work. Mark Bushman seconded the motion, and all were in favor. Isaac Bailey made a motion to pay Mark Moore \$22.50 per hour. Mark Bushman seconded the motion, and all were in favor.


