The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the September 13, 2021 meeting were read and approved.

Discussion started with the Webster School property. There was nothing to report on the electricity. Isaac Bailey will use the township tractor for a hay ride during the Trunk or Treat and car and tractor show Velocity is hosting on October 16.

Isaac Bailey asked multiple contractors for a quote for the labor for the shelter house but has not gotten a response yet. Isaac Bailey did find some contractors willing to do the concrete work.

Isaac Bailey reported the flag poles at the Township Hall and Webster Township Cemetery have been removed, and the new flag poles have been ordered. The Trustees discussed using the old hole for the cemetery flag pole.

Julie Foos presented an updated draft of the athletic field reservation paperwork for the Trustees to review. Isaac Bailey moved to charge \$10 per team per season. Jim Cajka seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

Mark Bushman reported the County is going to do some mowing in the coming week. Isaac Bailey found some potholes and will ask the County to Durapatch again. The Trustees discussed the shared section of Anderson Road and what can be done to improve it.

There was nothing to report on the abandoned houses or sealing the cemetery drive.

The ditch cleaning project is almost done. The Trustees agreed the ditch has been draining well as have the catch basins that were fixed on Dunipace and Silverwood Roads.

Julie Foos mentioned the newsletter is about half done and will present it at the next meeting.

The Trustees and Julie Foos discussed the Wood County Park District grant applications. Julie Foos relayed a few quotes for playground equipment, and the Trustees agreed to use one application for half of the new playground equipment. Isaac Bailey is going to get a quote for the stone and labor needed for a drive and walking path around the Webster School property.

Randy Aspacher mentioned he had some stone hauled in to use on the Webster School property.

Mark Bushman moved to accept Resolution 21-008, A Resolution Accepting the Amounts and Rates as Determined by the Budget Commission and Authorizing the Necessary Tax Levies and Certifying Them to the County Auditor. Isaac Bailey seconded the motion and all were in favor.

Julie Foos asked the Trustees to think about what expenses could be put towards the \$500 MORE grant through OTARMA for 2021.

The Trustees and Julie Foos discussed the Wreaths Across America event scheduled for December 18. Isaac Bailey made a motion to host Wreaths Across America at both cemeteries this year. Jim Cajka seconded the motion, and all were in favor. Mark Bushman moved to sponsor two wreaths. Jim Cajka seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

Jim Cajka relayed a conversation he had with Eastwood Superintendent Brent Welker. Brent Welker suggested Webster Township and neighboring townships use their ARP money to help fund running a water line from Luckey to the Eastwood campus. The Trustees agreed they do not want to spend the township's ARP money in this manner.
