The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the September 28, 2020 meeting were read and approved. The Fiscal Officer's report was also approved.

Julie Foos figured the township saved \$9,600 by having Randy Aspacher berm Main Road. Gerken Paving, Inc.'s final invoice was \$1,800 less than expected for paving Main Road.

Mark Bushman reported 52 truck tires were illegally dumped into the ditch on Webster Road. A Sheriff's report was filed. The Trustees discussed the best way to dispose of them. Mark Bushman is going to talk to Miller Insurance about the issue.

There was nothing to report on the building at the Webster School property. The Trustees reviewed the quotes for a flagpole to be put between the ball diamonds. Isaac Bailey would like to have Yankee Doodle Flags look at the existing flagpoles in Webster Township Cemetery and at the Township Hall. Jim Cajka made a motion to go with the fiberglass 25' flagpole. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor.

There was nothing to report on the corner of Silverwood Road and State Route 105 or on abandoned houses.

Isaac Bailey sprayed the roadsides on Anderson Road from State Route 582 to State Route 199 and Main Road and will continue until he runs out of spray. Jim Cajka found someone interested in spraying who has done work for municipalities in the past. Isaac Bailey will contact him.

Julie Foos will continue to try to find someone who can make stencils for the cemetery drive. Mark Bushman commented the Historical Cemetery Walk put on by the Pemberville Public Library went very well. Jim Cajka moved the portable restroom to the old outhouse foundation. Mark and Blake Bushman cleaned up the arborvitaes. Julie Foos updated the Trustees on the Wreaths Across America event which will be held at Webster Township Cemetery along with three cemeteries in Freedom Township on December 19. The Trustees would like to add Old Belleville Cemetery if there are extra wreaths. Julie Foos asked about the veteran markers the Trustees previously decided to remove based on no record of service. Mark Bushman would like to wait to remove them until their families are contacted.

The Trustees discussed the bridge replacement on Anderson Road. The approach is going to be higher than anticipated. The County is going to take full responsibility for maintaining the part of the ditch they are going to enclose near the southwest corner of the bridge. The landowner is concerned the County may not live up to the agreement, so the township will keep the letter with the agreement on file.

There was nothing to report on a replacement for the Zoning Commission.

Isaac Bailey has not gathered any more documentation for the bill for ODOT following the State Route 582 project. The County is supposed to get in touch with ODOT as well.

Isaac Bailey moved to accept Melinda Kale's nomination and Resolution 20-016, A Resolution Submitting Votes to Fill a Vacant Board Seat on the Northwestern Water and Sewer District as written. Jim Cajka seconded the motion and all were in favor.

Isaac Bailey mentioned trunk or treat along with the car and tractor show hosted by Velocity is scheduled for October 24. The last movie night Velocity held had a decent turn out.


Julie Foos has been working with Joyce Nowak to determine the right way to legally accept donations. Julie Foos will call some other townships to see how they handle the issue.




