The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the February 14, 2022 meeting were read and approved. The Fiscal Officer's report was also approved.

Randy Aspacher reported after the new overhead door opener was installed, the wire inside the wall went bad. Sarver & Sons Construction put a new control on the door.

The Velocity Board members had some suggestions for the athletic field reservation policy that will better protect their organization and assets if other teams want to use the facilities as well. The Board is concerned about being responsible for part of the electricity costs and for providing a portable restroom and trash removal and then having other teams use it for free. Julie Foos agreed the policy will have to be tweaked as things evolve. Greg Gonyer has been contacted by two other teams who want to use the fields for practices. Velocity would like to have a private storage container by the north field to store line paint and such. James Conway asked if Velocity could put up a "Reserved" sign on the fields. The Township will not allow such a sign since the fields are open to the public when not reserved by Velocity or other teams. Isaac Bailey made a motion to allow Velocity to advertise on the fields per the agreement. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor. The Velocity Board and the Trustees discussed other signs that may be appropriate. Randy Aspacher is working on figuring out how to get electricity to the concession stand, and everyone discussed the logistics of burying the wire while games and practices are going on. Isaac made a motion to accept the changes to the athletic field reservation policy. Mark Bushman seconded the motion, and all were in favor. Mark Bushman made a motion to have Greg Gonyer be the Scheduler. Isaac Bailey seconded the motion, and all were in favor. Greg Gonyer mentioned Velocity is going to host the car and tractor show on October 15 at the Webster School property.

There was nothing to report on the shelter house.

Julie Foos reported the contract for the 2021 NatureWorks grant has been fully executed. Julie Foos will call DWA Recreation and get an updated quote for the playground equipment and installation. The Trustees and Julie Foos discussed ideas for the 2022 grant application such as a walking path around the property. Jim Cajka wondered if the playground equipment could be sold on GovDeals. Isaac Bailey called everyone who has previously expressed interest in the equipment and has not gotten a response. Isaac Bailey made a motion to table the ODNR grant until the next meeting. Mark Bushman seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

Jim Cajka relayed a quote for a 300 gallon double-walled fuel tank with a new hose and new meter. Isaac Bailey made a motion to table the fuel tank purchase. Mark Bushman seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

Isaac Bailey made a motion to purchase the spreader box from Troy Township for \$2,500. Jim Cajka seconded the motion, and all were in favor. The Trustees talked about potholes that need fixed throughout the township. Isaac Bailey mentioned the County does not have any cold mix available. Mark Bushman will see if the County will be Durapatching soon. The Trustees and Randy Aspacher talked about roads that need improved this year. Jim Cajka will ask Premier Patching to quote smoothing out Alexander Road before it is chip sealed. Isaac Bailey said the stone section of Anderson Road needs some attention before farmers start planting.

There was nothing to report on abandoned houses.

Randy Aspacher took the wreaths from Wreaths Across America to the landfill. Randy Aspacher also reported Redline Equipment finished its work on the tractor. Randy Aspacher is

going to take the plow for the small truck to Kalida to have better lights installed.

Randy Aspacher has noticed multiple signs are missing on the roads. Isaac Bailey mentioned the County will OUPS where the new signs from the LTAP Sign Grant will be installed.

Isaac Bailey said the County's records department does not contract with other entities. Isaac Bailey will call the Ohio Township Association to see if there are other contractors.

Isaac Bailey said the old equipment being sold on GovDeals should be gone by the end of March. Isaac Bailey made a motion to put the link on the Township's Facebook page. Mark Bushman seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

Isaac Bailey will continue to work on the arrangements for the Roadside and Community Clean-Up Day on April 23.

The Trustees briefly reviewed the health insurance renewal. Isaac Bailey made a motion to table the health insurance renewal. Mark Bushman seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

Randy Aspacher asked if the County was going to do anything about the ditch on Luckey Road. No action has been taken.


