The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the March 23, 2020 meeting were read and approved.

The Trustees began by discussing the Webster School property. Isaac Bailey reported the soccer association will not be using the property because their spring season has been canceled. Jim Cajka asked the Parks District to make some recommendations regarding the playground. Mark Bushman would like to see the brush cut out from under the bleachers.

The Trustees reviewed the quote from the County for improving Main Road. Jim Cajka relayed an estimate from Unilliance and asked about splitting the project over two years. Because of the way contractors charge, it would most likely be cheaper to do the project in one year. Isaac Bailey made a motion to ask for bids for Main Road from Dowling Road to State Route 199. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor. Mark Bushman will get the bid packet from the County.

Mark Bushman asked Joyce Nowak with the Prosecutor's Office about options for limiting access to the stone section of Anderson Road but has not heard back. Jim Cajka would like to have the County finish cutting the bank down and have Randy Aspacher continue to haul in stone. The Trustees discussed what side of the road to put the dirt on. Jim Cajka would like to know how much more money the township would receive if the road was improved versus unimproved. Mark Bushman will see Jason Sisco with the County thinks about improving the stone section of the road.

The Trustees decided to hold off on any microsealing until they make a decision about improving Main Road. Mark Bushman will ask the County to Durapatch a few holes.

Mark Bushman will get another quote from Sarver & Sons Construction regarding the township hall driveway.

Isaac Bailey made a motion to accept a bid on sealcoating the Webster Township Cemetery. The motion died for a lack of a second. Isaac Bailey will get some clarification on the quote.

There was nothing to report on the Fire and EMS contracts, the roadside spraying program, abandoned houses, or the potential Zoning Commission replacement.

Mark Bushman talked to ODOT again about the corner of Silverwood Road and State Route 105 but is not hopeful they will repair the hole anytime soon.

Jim Cajka did order pallet forks and will order a quick hitch for the tractor.

Isaac Bailey will figure out how many 911 address signs need to be replaced.

Mark Bushman reported Bill Subsara would like to replace the war markers for the veterans without any markers who are buried at the Webster Township Cemetery. The Trustees talked about where to get the markers. Bill Subsara is working on a list of issues that need to be addressed and corrected.

Isaac Bailey made a motion to pay OPERS for March before the next meeting. Mark Bushman seconded the motion and all were in favor.

Mark Bushman made a motion to cancel the second April meeting in consideration of the coronavirus. Isaac Bailey seconded the motion and all were in favor.




