

GRAND RAPIDS TOWNSHIP REGULAR MEETING

April 26, 2021

The Grand Rapids Township Trustees met at 7:00 P.M. in the Grand Rapids Township Fire Hall. Ike Topp, David Chamberlain and Rita Foos answered roll call. There were three guests.

Rita Foos moved to approve and dispense with the reading of the minutes, as copies were available to guests. 2nd by Ike Topp. Roll Call YES: Ike Topp, David Chamberlain and Rita Foos. Motion carried.

The Fiscal Officer presented bills in the amount of \$9,794.99 for approval. Rita Foos moved to pay all bills as presented. 2nd by David Chamberlain. Roll Call YES: David Chamberlain, Ike Topp and Rita Foos. Motion carried.

Zoning inspector Brad Trumbull turned in a fence permit and informed the Board that the Health Department got involved with the property on Milton road and that they appear to be cleaning it up because a dumpster has been delivered to the property.

There was a review of the recommendations for road repairs received from Wood County Engineer Jason Sisco. David Chamberlain mentioned that he met with Mike Metzger and that Mike recommended wedge patching and micro surfacing and that he is still waiting on an estimate. Rita Foos said that we should also consider crack sealing Poe Road.

Ike Topp reported that the culvert under Poe Road by Sailor Lane was full of sand and that the County jetted it out and is going to Contact the land owners about cleaning out the ditch now that the water is flowing again.

Rita Foos said she was contacted by the Health Department to have a vaccination clinic on May 7 in the fire station. Rita stated that she did not think it was a good idea to have the clinic in the fire station because of security issues and that Chief Flora was not in favor of using the station for the clinic. Ike Topp agreed that if the Chief is not in favor of it we should not do it. David Chamberlain moved to not hold a vaccination clinic in the fire station. 2nd by Rita Foos. Roll Call YES: Ike Topp, David Chamberlain and Rita Foos. Motion carried.

Les Heyman informed the Board and all present that the Fire Department will be holding a chicken Barbecue July 10, 2021.
