The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the September 26, 2022 meeting were read and approved.

Jim Cajka and Isaac Bailey talked to Dave Steiner with the Planning Commission about their plan to create a new parcel on Fish Road, and there is no changing the decision.

Randy Aspacher reported he took both trucks in to be repaired at Bayer Auto. Randy Aspacher also mentioned Becker Tree Service cut down the tree on the Dunipace Road and trimmed some branches.

Isaac Bailey reported the permit for the shelter house should be approved in the coming week.

Randy Aspacher and Matt Hemp put up shelves in the storage building and started lining the bottom of the walls. Matt Hemp relayed a quote for spraying insulation in the walls, but no action was taken.

Julie Foos talked about some grants that are available for the playground.

The County fixed the washouts on Silverwood Road and Devils Hole Road. Isaac Bailey said the County will finish installing the road signs in the coming week.

The cemetery grant agreement was received by the Department of Commerce, so the township can begin building the kiosk at any time.

There was nothing to report on the cell towers. Independents Fiber Network will meet with Dave Welling to get their road bore permits.

Julie Foos will continue to work on the newsletter and should have a draft by the next meeting.

Jim Cajka moved to appoint Brooke Hahn to the seat on the Northwestern Water & Sewer District Board. Isaac Bailey seconded the motion and all were in favor. Resolution 22-008, a Resolution Submitting Votes to Fill a Vacant Board Seat on the Northwestern Water and Sewer District was approved.

Julie Foos reviewed the information about the group accident insurance plan, and everyone agreed the benefits were not worth the cost.

Julie Foos will be attending a virtual public records training. Mark Bushman moved to designate Julie Foos as all three Trustees' proxy for the training. Jim Cajka seconded the motion, and all were in favor.
