The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the October 10, 2022 meeting were read and approved. The Fiscal Officer's report was also approved.

Isaac Bailey reported a farmer dropped a disk near Silverwood Road and Alexander Road, and the County fixed the damage the next day. Isaac Bailey provided the farmer with the bill for the damages, and the farmer already reimbursed the township.

The Trustees discussed the tree and limbs that were taken down on Dunipace Road.

Randy Aspacher said a tree fell in the river near Chamberlain Road and State Route 105. Randy Aspacher and Matt Hemp removed the tree and put it in the existing brush pile.

Isaac Bailey reported the building permit for the shelter house was approved, and he notified Sarver and Sons Construction. No work has started yet.

Isaac Bailey mentioned Velocity held their car and tractor show at the Webster School property. There were less people there than the last time. Greg Gonyer will have the portable restroom removed when the softball teams are done using the fields for the year.

Julie Foos questioned if the pedestal for the merry-go-round will be removed. Randy Aspacher hopes Sarver and Sons Construction will be able to remove it with their equipment when they build the shelter house. Mark Bushman will look into it. Julie Foos reviewed the requirements for the ODNR grant. Mark Bushman signed the Certificate of Compliance. Isaac Bailey will work on getting the addendum to the deed to the property properly recorded with the County.

Julie Foos reminded the Trustees that the Park District will come out to inspect the playground and point out issues that need fixed. Julie Foos will call and try to get someone out to the playground this fall. Randy Aspacher mentioned a few of the bolts in the train spring's handle broke. Randy Aspacher has not been able to find the right replacement. Julie Foos will contact DWA Recreation to see if the equipment is under warranty.

The Trustees talked about having a special meeting regarding the improvements that have already happened and improvements they would like to make to the Webster School property. Mark Bushman moved to have a special meeting on November 28 at 7:00 P.M. Isaac Bailey seconded the motion, and all were in favor. Julie Foos will contact Morlock Asphalt for an estimate for repaving the parking lot, adding additional pavement in places, and paving a walking path around the property.

Mark Bushman reported the County fixed all the washouts except on the southern end of Silverwood Road. Randy Aspacher and Matt Hemp added stone to it a while ago which seems to be holding up.

Isaac Bailey mentioned the County is almost done installing the new road signs. Isaac Bailey will question when the County will send the bill for the labor.

The Trustees talked about the shared stone section of Anderson Road. Randy Aspacher dragged it this past spring, and it seems to be holding up fine. Randy Aspacher said there are a few low spots, so he will drag it again next spring. Isaac Bailey and Mark Bushman would like to go to Center Township's next meeting to discuss improving the shared paved section of Anderson Road. There was no news about the OPWC grant for improving Swan Road.

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Isaac Bailey spot-sprayed some brush throughout the township this past year. Isaac Bailey would like to see the County mow off some of the bigger brush, and then the township will keep up on it. Mark Bushman will contact the County with a list of roadsides that need mowed.

Julie Foos mentioned the row numbers for the remaining two sections of Webster Township Cemetery have been painted. Isaac Bailey will ask the County to make a No Snowmobiling sign to install on the fence. Julie Foos will ask Bill Subsara a few questions about people who may be veterans but have no marker.

There was nothing to report on the cell towers.

Julie Foos presented a draft of the newsletter to the Trustees and a quote from The Copy Shop. Isaac Bailey made a motion to send the newsletter to all residents and taxpayers.

The Trustees discussed the members on the zoning boards whose terms are up at the end of the year. The Trustees talked about possible replacements.




