The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer. The minutes from the June 27, 2022 meeting were read and approved.

Jim Cajka reported Premier Patching finished up their work on various township roads last Friday, and all the Trustees agreed they did a good job.

Isaac Bailey will resubmit the building permit to the County after getting the engineered drawings stamped. Randy Aspacher reported the electricity project is complete, and the softball teams have been using the electricity in the concession stand. Randy Aspacher replaced the dented panels on the storage building, but Morton Buildings has not come out to fix the leak in the roof yet. The double-walled fuel tank has been ordered but is eight weeks out.

The Main Road ditch cleaning project has not been started yet. The Trustees agreed to have the County tar and chip with 9's all of Layman Road, Alexander Road from State Route 199 to Fish Road, Caris Road from Devils Hole Road to State Route 582, Silverwood Road from the south township line to Nelson Road, and Nelson Road from Silverwood Road to Anderson Road. Randy Aspacher mentioned the County has not fixed the three washouts yet. Jim Cajka questioned who is responsible for fixing the washout on Nelson Road caused by Toledo Edison's guide wire. Randy Aspacher said the barrel marking the washout on Devils Hole went missing.

Julie Foos has been working on the database for Webster Township Cemetery. Julie Foos reported a cemetery grant opened up, and building the kiosk would qualify. Mark Bushman will work on getting a material list and quote for the application.

Mark Bushman and Jim Cajka went to the village of Luckey's last council meeting. The council decided to set a date in the future at which the ordinance they passed regarding properties annexing into the village before tapping into the public utilities will go into effect. The three properties in question will be exempt, so the annexation discussion is off the table.

Jim Cajka mentioned Independents Fiber Network put in the drive for the cell tower project on Layman Road. Jim Cajka believes they plan to tie into an existing underground line on Sugar Ridge Road and will contact the company for more information.

The Trustees reviewed the Estimate of Revenue for 2023. Mark Bushman made a motion to accept the Estimate of Revenue. Isaac Bailey seconded the motion, and all were in favor.

Julie Foos reported Nexus pipeline's many appeals have been settled for around 68% of the original valuation. Nexus will owe the township an additional payment to make up for underpaying the last few years and is expected to make that payment in October.
